

HELPING TO LEAD THE ROSARY AT THE GROTTO

LITTLE HOUSE OF BERNADETTE CHILDREN & FAMILIES CENTRE



Location: In the Hemicycle (hall and small rooms upstairs), the 'Little House of Bernadette' welcomes children aged 0 to around 12, accompanied by their families, or their leaders and catechists.

Description: The aim of this centre is to help children grow in their desire to draw closer to God through the Virgin Mary, in the footsteps of Saint Bernadette.

A team of experienced activity leaders is on hand to accompany you throughout your time at our dedicated children and families centre.

- Story of the apparitions: the beautiful story of Saint Bernadette and the apparitions told in a childfriendly way, with little characters to move around.
- Various games to learn about the message of Lourdes and the life of Saint Bernadette (board games, puzzles, Playmobil of the grotto...)
- Children's procession to the Garden of Reflection, opposite the Grotto.
- New attractions for the 2025 season!
- There's a special area for toddlers (play mats, cubes) and a changing table

The oratory at the entrance allows those who so wish to conclude their visit with a time of prayer

YOUTH VILLAGE

Located 10 minutes' walk from the Sanctuary, the Youth Village offers accommodation and catering services that are particularly wellsuited to welcoming groups of young people and fostering an experience of community life. We have buildings with bedrooms or dormitories, a self-service restaurant, kitchens and refectories for hire, places for celebrations and vigils, campsites with showers and toilets, etc. Total capacity: around 400 beds in buildings; 2,000 camping spaces.

Simple comforts, but green surroundings guaranteed.

During the winter of 2024-2025, the Cana building will be completely renovated (60-bed capacity, creation of leaders' rooms, renovation of sanitary facilities), with the creation of a "presbytery" containing 7 priests' rooms. SANCTUAIRE NOTRE-DAME DE LOURDES



TO LEARN MORE IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF BERNADETTE

Make the most of your pilgrimage by exploring these two other major sites near Lourdes, which have been shaped by the presence of Saint Bernadette.



Bartrès

Discover Bartrès, a charming little village nestling in the Bigourdan countryside, with its picturesque and unspoilt sites where Bernadette Soubirous spent her time. It was in this village from November 1845 to April <u>1846 that</u>

It was in this village from November 1845 to April 1846 that Bernadette Soubirous, barely ten months old, was entrusted to the care of Marie Lagües, who had just lost her baby boy. In September 1857, when she was 13 years old, her former nanny, in need of help, brought her back to look after her young children and entrusted her with the care of a flock of sheep. Bernadette returned to her family in Lourdes in January 1858, just a few weeks before the first apparition of the Virgin Mary at the Grotto of Massabielle.

A pretty, signposted path (5 km - 1hr 15 walk) links the Sanctuary of Lourdes to the village of Bartrés, where you can visit the sheepfold where Bernadette tended her flock, as well as the church of Saint- John the Baptist.

Sanctuary of Our Lady of Betharram

Bétharram, in the Béarn region of France, is a very old Marian sanctuary. At its foot runs the Gave, which, some fifteen kilometres upstream, borders the grotto in Lourdes. At this spot, more than 500 years ago, a young girl was picking flowers by the river. The waters were deep and full of eddies. To complete her bouquet, she unexpectedly ventured close to the bank; her foot slipped on the wet grass; in an instant, she was swept away by the current. There was no one to hear her cry for help; but her faith was greater than her fear. She invoked the Blessed Virgin.

Immediately, a branch from who knows where appeared on the surface of the water. The little girl clung to it and was pulled to shore.

As a sign of gratitude for the grace she had received, she had a goldsmith make her a golden branch, which she offered to the Virgin of the Sanctuary. Since then, she has been venerated as Our Lady of the Beautiful Branch, beth-arram in the Bearn dialect.

The rosary that Bernadette used during the apparitions had been bought during a pilgrimage to Betharram, a few days before the apparitions. Afterwards, she had several opportunities to speak with the future saint, Father Michel Garicoïts, and to tell him about the extraordinary experience with which she had been blessed.


